2. ORGANISATION

SUBJECTS ORGANISED BY LEVELS: Concept, organisation and work:

Taking into account the document Alfredo Muñoz wrote and the conversations, the project should consider a multiplicity of scales, exercises and objectives, depending on the level that is taught. This way, we could see it as an Open Strategy Project Plan.

This would basically consist in:

- a- General intervention at an urban scale (reactivation of the traces in its de-configuration, new borders, borders, new uses and functions, program reconsideration, conceptually, new parks, hyper-green corridors, new building areas, etc. URBAN-TERRITORY SCALE.
- b- Intervention in an urban design scale, of regeneration and reutilization of the residual ambits of the schemes, interconnection points. URBAN SCALE.
- c- Projects of an objective scale (urban design, micro-design). MICROSCALE.
- d- Building projects (new uses, functions, programmes: museums, habitable, terciary...). MEDIUM AND SUPER SCALE.

- e- Multiconnections: bridges, piers... MEDIUM AND SUPER SCALE.
- f- This scheme allows the interconnectivity between units. This would be very important because it would lead us to establish reprogramming and connections between units in a continuous way.
